

La Trobe University Baseball Club - Alcohol Management Policy

Responsibility of the Club

The club will abide by and fulfil the requirements in relation to documentation, process, display etc as required under the Liquor Control Reform act of 1998 or amendments as legislated from time to time.

This will include but not limited to the posting in a prominent position in the club of the following:

- Licence
- Name of nominee
- Responsible serving posters
- Notice of underage drinking
- Individual clubs responsible drinking notice
- Club code of conduct
- 1. Where a club provides alcohol for sale or consumption it shall be done in accordance with the provisions of the Liquor Control Reform Act of 1998.
- 2. The licence document including details of the nominee will be displayed in a prominent position within the club.
- 3. Persons who handle and dispense alcohol at the club will be well versed in club policy and rules, and trained to ensure they are aware of their responsibilities under this policy.
- 4. Persons serving alcohol at the club will be trained and aware of the current requirement under the act in the provision of alcohol, including serving under age and intoxicated persons.
- 5. The club will ensure the safety of their members and where appropriate provide alternate transport options for members who exceed or are suspected to exceed the legal driving limit.
- 6. Ensure the local taxi number is displayed in a prominent position.
- 7. The club will make available tap water at all times when alcohol is served at no cost.
- 8. The club will sell low alcohol and or non-alcoholic beverages at all times.
- 9. Low alcohol beverages will be sold at a lower price than full strength products. (Minimum 10% lower).
- 10. Ensure that food is available to members and guests of the club whilst alcohol is being made available.
- 11. The club will refrain from providing alcohol as prizes for player awards.



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- 12. The club is aware of our responsibilities to guests and members at the club and ensures the provisions of this policy are enforced.
- 13. The club will have a designated official on duty when alcohol is served to ensure all the provisions of the policy are adhered to.
- 14. Any infractions of the policy will be dealt with by the committee of the club.
- 15. A person found to have disobeyed or knowingly violated club policy or legal requirements will be dealt with at the discretion of the club's Committee including suspension from the premises or from playing baseball should the matter be deemed an irresponsible breach.

Responsibilities of Members

- 1. Players and members will act in a responsible manner at all times and to demonstrate control and moderation in the way they conduct themselves in relation to the consumption of alcohol at the club.
- 2. Players and members will refrain from heavy intake of alcohol and binge drinking.
- 3. Players and members will provide assistance to fellow players and members if they observe unacceptable behaviour at the club and will bring the matter to the attention of the appropriate club official.
